**MINUTES OF COUNCIL 12932 REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING
Tuesday, August 22, 2017**

The regular monthly meeting was called to order at 7:00. GK Eric Ganson was presiding.

Chaplain's Message: Fr. Mike stated he looked forward to having a message in future months for the Council but at tonight's meeting there was no message.

Approval of the Minutes from Previous Meeting: Minutes from the July meeting were handed out prior to the meeting. A motion to accept the minutes was made by Eric Ganson with a second by Vernon Wilson. After a vote, the motion passed.

We have 0 new members toward our goal of seven and 0 new insurance with a goal of 3. Twenty three of our members have outstanding dues for a total of \$1,500.00.

Membership Committee Report: State Membership Director John Schulz suggested that we recruit early this year. John would like to be at least half way to our goal by December. Recruiting early helps our insurance agent meet his goals.

- 3. Religious Ed Raffle:** Our Council is responsible for 6 of the tickets this year. The Council will buy one for Council and one for the Parish. The four remaining tickets were bought by Knights in attendance.
