**MINUTES OF COUNCIL 12932 REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING
Tuesday, September 25th, 2018**

Financial Secretary's Report: FS Joe Pelzel emailed in the following report: As of tonight we have 99 members. Forty-one are insurance members, 57 associate, 1 inactive, 1 honorary and 5 honorary life members. We are -2 members toward our goal of 7 and -2 new insurance with a goal of 3. Twenty-two of our members have outstanding dues for a total of \$1,675.00.
